- Veterinary Technician licensed in the state of Missouri.
- Active member in good standing with the MOVTA
- The nominee cannot be a current MOVTA executive member.
- Nominees will be considered based on:
 - o State and local animal care activities, community service
 - o Contributions to technician advancement
 - o Published materials, project presentations, and special achievements
 - o Leadership positions held
- Nominations forms must be submitted along with the following minimum requirements.
 - o One letter of recommendation from a RVT.
 - o One letter of recommendation from a DVM. OR
 - o Two letters of recommendation from two different RVTs.

Only nominations that have followed and met the above criteria will be considered. Completed nominations must be received by August 31st of each calendar year. Application and letters must be emailed to <u>vtoty@movta.org</u>.
